## Children's Activities Provided:

For the first time at a National Conference/Certification Event, activities will be provided for elementary aged children by a certified childcare provider. This service is available for \$25 a day per child, which begins 15 minutes prior to classes and lasts until 15 minutes after the last class. It also includes the cost of lunch. Note: Activities will be onsite only and will exclude the pool.

## Certification:

For those who register and attend classes July 12-July 18, 50 hours of course credit hours will be available.
